Application No: 19/00056/OUT Decision Level: Delegated

Proposal: Proposed residential development comprising up to 7no. dwellings (all matters reserved for subsequent approval)

Location: Land At 1 And 3 Main Street Palterton

Applicant: Mr & Mrs S Hodgkinson & Mrs Longden

Resolved: It has no objections to the plots shown as 1 to 5 as they fall within the "footprint" of existing housing and do not increase the southern extremity of housing in Palterton.

However, it does have concerns about Plots 6 and 7 as they will move the southernmost point of housing in Palterton and in general the Parish Council supports "in-fill" development rather than extension of housing boundaries.

FC19/028

To consider a request from The Soap Box Derby 2019 to have the use of the Football Field and top area of the Recreation Ground as a Car Park during this year's event.

The council **resolved** to allow the use of the field as a car park for the event, but some conditions must be met:

1. The cars must keep away from the children's play area.
2. Any damage to the field must be fully repaired as a matter of urgency.
3. The area must be marshalled.

FC19/029 **To consider a budget reports and bank reconciliation.**
It was **resolved** to note and approve these reports.
It was noted that Palterton residents are concerned about the play area at the Village Hall and the Clerk is to attempt to gain a grant to move the area forward and to fence it.

It was reported that DCC had requested the removal of the brick shelter on Main Street, Scarcliffe as the ground works were due to start. It was **resolved** to endorse the Chair's actions to instruct a local contractor to remove the shelter. It was also noted that the bench and planter near this shelter were in a very poor state of repair. It was **resolved** to organise the replacement of these two items.
