County Councillor Dixon reported:
Rylah Hillis to be closed from the 17th of February for 3 weeks (this has also been mentioned in the Newsletter with a link to the One Network).
The missing "Hillstown" sign on the right-hand side entering Hillstown is being investigated. Parts of Wells Street and Cross Street are to be resurfaced and it has again been reported that the "lead" on Wells St across the pavement is still there.
Members of the public commented:
Illegal parking of a horse transporter and horse box has been reported at Hillstown Business Park. It was also reported that a notice requesting this vehicles removal had been placed on it
This site is also been used for Band Practice causing noise disturbance.
The new sign at Junction 29 has been knocked down.
